



SHANAGARRY bobbled at the start, moved up on the two path through the turn, came three wide to bid and closed for a share. LUNA SANTA passed tiring rivals. SLIVER OF HOPE set the pace on the inside and had no stretch rally. SUNSET SILHOUETTE tracked the pace on the inside and steadily lost ground.









WONDROUSWAGER stalked the pace on the outside, bid between rivals into the stretch and faded in the drive. GLENSTAL ABBEY improved position. HOWABOUTWE ran evenly. NOWHERE TO RUN showed little. SPECIALNIGHTACTION was no factor. MANDATARIO fractious in the gate, was outrun and eased over the wire.
